



Policy for organizing a fundraising event

- 1.** This policy has been formulated to protect the reputation and integrity of the Laurent Duvernay-Tardif (LDT) Foundation and its members when third parties organize fundraising activities. We ask that all people involved in organizing the activity understand and respect the following conditions.
- 2.** Organizers who wish to organize a fundraising activity must fill out the form for organizing a fundraising activity available on the LDT Foundation website.
- 3.** The LDT Foundation bears no cost and assumes no liability associated with the activities of a third party.
- 4.** The organizers agree to make the request and to obtain all permits, licences, and insurance necessary for holding the activity.
- 5.** All employees or volunteers at the fundraising activity organized by a third party must be recruited by the activity organizers.
- 6.** The fundraising activity's organizers, employees, and volunteers must be clearly identified as volunteers and may under no circumstances identify themselves as employees or members of the LDT Foundation.
- 7.** As per its confidentiality policy, the LDT Foundation does not share contact information for any of its donors with the organizers of fundraising activities.
- 8.** The LDT Foundation logo and visual elements may not be used without the written consent of the Foundation. Their use without permission is strictly forbidden. All promotional items bearing the name and/or logo of the LDT Foundation must be approved beforehand.
- 9.** The LDT Foundation never supports a third party that practises any form of discrimination against any individual or group based on sex, nationality, economic status, ethnicity, gender identity, age, handicap, religion, or political affiliation or any other form of discrimination. Activities held by third parties must comply with the standards of the code of ethics.



- 10.** When applicable, the LDT Foundation is responsible for issuing tax receipts related to the fundraising activity organized. The LDT Foundation is responsible for setting up the funding platform.
- 11.** The participation of Laurent Duvernay-Tardif cannot be guaranteed for the fundraising activity.
- 12.** We strongly encourage the organizers to orient their fundraising activity in such a way as to support the LDT Foundation's mission as much as possible and promote it to the best of their capacity.
- 13.** By accepting the terms and conditions established in this document, the organizers understand and accept liability for any claim related to the activity.
- 14.** By naming the LDT Foundation as beneficiary of an activity organized by a third party, you are held responsible for remitting all profits (or an amount that is predetermined and approved by the Foundation) to the Foundation.
- 15.** The organizers of the activity indemnify and hold harmless the LDT Foundation and its entities, employees, volunteers, and directors for any claim arising in any way whatsoever from the holding of the fundraising activity.
